

# Adding fiber optic cable via suspension wire



## AI Overview

Fiber optic cables are typically suspended on a steel messenger wire using clamps, bands, or specialized suspension kits to ensure proper tension, sag, and protection from mechanical stress.

### Choosing the Suspension Wire

For aerial fiber optic installations, use a galvanized steel strand as the suspension wire. Common specifications are 7/2.2 mm for standard cables, or 7/2.0 mm for armored cables. The wire must support the cable's weight and withstand environmental forces like wind and vibration (Bonelinks) .

### Tools and Accessories

You will need:

- Suspension clamps (e.g., HC-8-15) suitable for the cable diameter
- Stainless steel bands and buckles
- Strapping or banding tool (e.g., MBT-004)
- Hammer for securing hardware
- Optional catenary suspension kits for tool-free tensioning and rapid installation (Gripple)
