- Sidewall height matching: Ensure the coupler's height range matches the trays being connected to avoid misalignment or stress on the tray structure .
- Load and support: Verify that the adjusted tee maintains proper support for the cables, considering the weight and spacing of the cables in the tray .
- Accessibility: Adjust the coupler so that the tee connection allows sufficient clearance for cable installation and maintenance.
