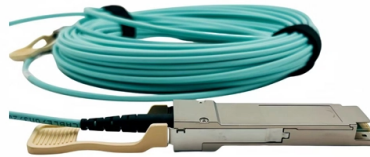

Electrical wiring color coding assigns specific colors to each wire, enabling technicians to quickly identify its function, thereby ensuring safety, reducing maintenance time, and preventing wiring errors. The various colored wires that you can see when you look behind a switch or an outlet are not an accident, but rather a safety feature that is built in. Wiring color codes are. The standard permits the following colours for identifying conductors: The colours green and yellow on their own are only permitted where confusion with the colouring of the green/yellow protective conductor is unlikely. Combinations of the above colours are permitted, but green and yellow should.
