In hard rock conditions, a minimum of 300 mm (12 inches) cover is acceptable if additional protection, such as a concrete slab, is provided (). This ensures both optical cables and ducts are mechanically protected and reduces the risk of interference from other underground utilities.

Installation Best Practices

- Separation and bedding: Place sand or soft soil beneath and between ducts to cushion the cables and prevent abrasion ().
