Single-Mode Fiber Classifications (OS Series)

- OS1: Indoor single-mode fiber, typically tight-buffered, optimized for up to 2 km in optical loss-limited applications .
- OS2: Outdoor single-mode fiber, optimized for long-distance transmission, low attenuation, suitable for distances exceeding 10 km .
