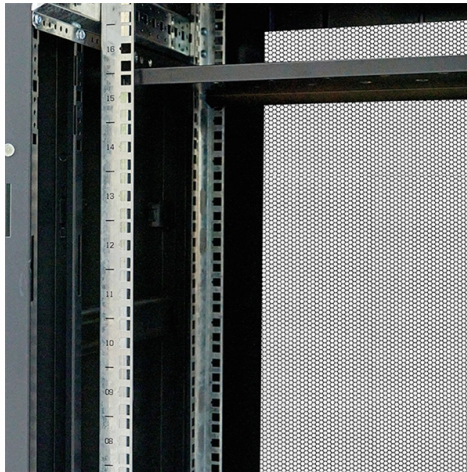


Connection between optical module and port

Even if two modules are electrically compatible, a connector mismatch can prevent proper connection without adapters.
