Key Steps for Grounding a Distribution Box

1. Identify Grounding Points Open the distribution box and locate the grounding bar (PE bar) or terminals marked with grounding symbols. These are the designated points for connecting the ground wire inside the box . 2. Select the Correct Ground Wire

- Use a copper core wire with a yellow-green insulation for visibility and safety .
- In the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) wire is standard; in other markets, a 6 mm² wire is recommended .
- For connections between mounting plates and components, larger wires may be required depending on cable length and system configuration (e.g., 16 mm² or 6 AWG for long tool cables), . 3. Connect the Ground Wire
- Strip the insulation at the wire end and attach it securely to the PE bar or grounding terminal using screws or bolts .
- Ensure all electrical components inside the box that require grounding are connected to the PE bar with copper wires .
- For metal enclosures, such as stainless steel boxes, use braided copper tape between the door panel and box body to maintain continuity, and apply conductive grease to prevent corrosion .
