

Do pre-branched cables still need to be installed in cable trays

Overview

Cable trays are designed to support and organize multiple cables in industrial, commercial, and data center environments, providing mechanical protection, ventilation, and ease of maintenance . Pre-branched cables—cables with factory-installed taps or terminations—can be installed in trays if they meet tray-rated standards such as TC (Tray Cable) or ITC (Instrumentation Tray Cable) and are UL listed for tray use .

NEC Compliance and Installation Rules

- Tray-rated cables: Only cables specifically rated for tray installation should be used. These include TC, TC-ER, ITC, and ITC-ER cables .
- ER (Exposure-Rated) cables: These cables can leave the tray for short distances (up to six feet) to connect to equipment, provided they are supported and secured at intervals not exceeding six feet . This is particularly relevant for pre-branched cables that have multiple tap points.
- Support and securing: Pre-branched cables must be continuously supported using mechanical protection such as struts, angles, or channels, and secured at regular intervals to prevent sagging or mechanical stress .
