- Connectorized (Mechanical) Termination – Attaching a connector directly to the fiber end.
- Fusion Splicing – Permanently joining the fiber to a pre-terminated pigtail or another fiber using an electric arc .

### Steps in Fiber Termination

Regardless of the method, the initial steps are similar:

- Stripping the Fiber: Remove the outer jacket and secondary coating, then strip the primary coating to expose the bare glass fiber .
- Cleaning: Use lint-free wipes and high-purity alcohol to remove dust, oils, and residue from the bare fiber .
- Cleaving: Precisely cut the fiber end to create a smooth, mirror-like surface for optimal light transmission .
