A fiber optic terminal box (FTB), also called a fiber termination or distribution box, is a protective enclosure that terminates, splices, and manages fiber optic cables. It typically consists of a main body and a splice tray or adapter tray that holds fiber connectors and splices securely. The box protects fibers from environmental damage, organizes excess fiber, and provides a centralized access point for network maintenance and upgrades. Terminal boxes can be indoor or outdoor, made from plastic or metal, and come in straight-through (single input) or branched-type (multiple inputs/outputs) configurations. They are widely used in FTTH networks, data centers, and enterprise LANs.

Connecting Fiber to the Terminal Box

- **Cable Preparation:** Strip the protective coating from the fiber optic cable carefully, ensuring the fiber core is clean and undamaged. Use a precision fiber stripper and lint-free wipes with 99% isopropyl alcohol to clean the fiber end.
- **Splicing:** Connect the incoming fiber to a pigtail (short fiber with a connector) using fusion splicing. Proper cleaving and alignment are critical to minimize insertion loss and signal attenuation. Each splice should be verified with an Optical Time Domain Reflectometer (OTDR) to ensure low-loss connections.
