 - **QSFP/QSFP28/QSFP56:** Multi-lane modules supporting 40 Gbps, 100 Gbps, and 200 Gbps respectively, used for high-density, high-speed connections .
 - **OSFP and CFP:** High-performance modules supporting 400 Gbps to 1.6 Tbps for ultra-high-speed data center applications .
