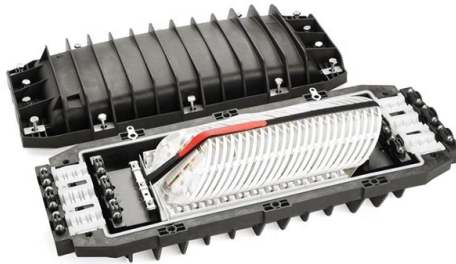


How often should fiberglass cable trays be replaced
