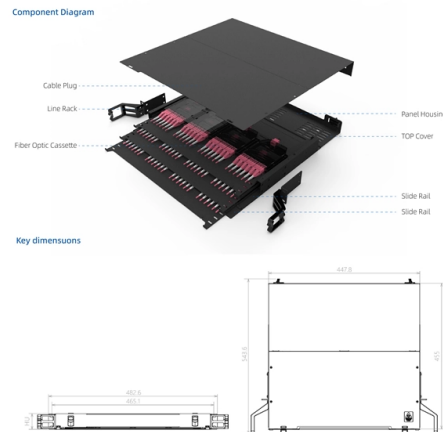

Simple Analog Control: 0-10V dimming uses a low-voltage DC signal (0-10 volts) on separate wires to provide smooth, flicker-free control over light levels, from 100% brightness down to a minimum.
