Key Selection Criteria

1. Fiber Type

- **Single-Mode (9/125μm, OS2):** Long-distance, high-bandwidth applications (10 km to 120 km+). Typically yellow jacketed. Supports 1G-400G networks .
- **Multimode (50/125μm OM2/OM3/OM4/OM5, 62.5/125μm OM1):** Shorter distances (100-550 m), lower cost. Color-coded jackets (orange for OM3, aqua for OM4) for easy identification .

2. Connector Type

- **LC:** High-density applications, common in data centers.
