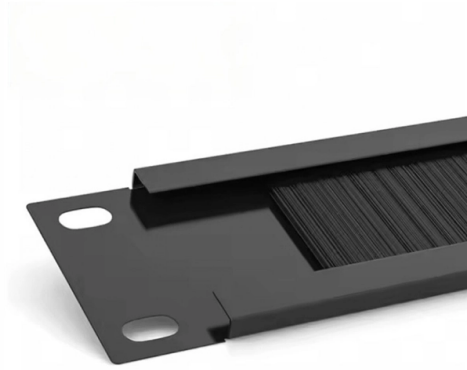


Minimum requirements for laying drop optical cables

Cable Types and Selection

Drop optical cables are typically designed for FTTH applications and may include duct cables, self-supporting figure-8 cables, or microcables.
