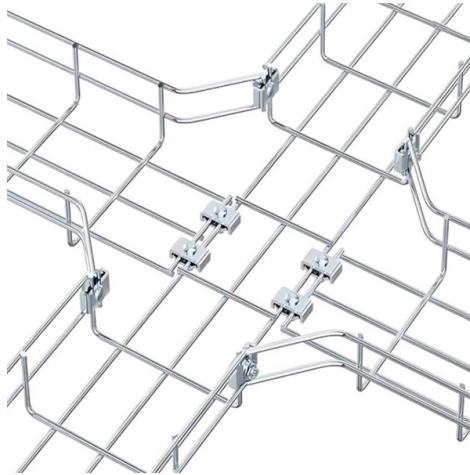


Recommended 45-degree bends for cable trays



AI Overview

45-degree bends in cable trays include flat bends, adjustable bends, and elbow fittings, designed for horizontal or vertical directional changes while maintaining cable integrity.

Flat Bends

Flat bends are pre-fabricated 45-degree sections used to change the direction of cable trays horizontally or vertically. They are available for light, medium, and heavy-duty trays with widths ranging from 50mm to 900mm. Materials include mild steel (pre-galvanized or hot-dip galvanized) and stainless steel (grade 316L). Flat bends can also be supplied with closed or ventilated covers to protect cables and allow airflow .

Adjustable bends offer flexibility for installations where precise angles are required. They can be configured to 30°, 45°, 60°, 75°, or 90°, making them suitable for medium and heavy-duty trays up to 300mm wide. This type allows installers to adapt the bend angle on-site, reducing the need for multiple pre-fabricated fittings .
