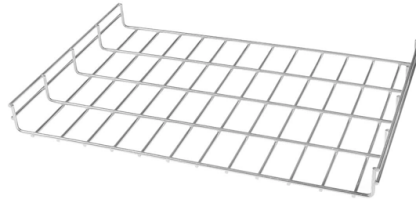


Room entrance electrical distribution box

 - Isolators and main breakers
 - Cable entries and wiring space for neat and safe connections
- The enclosure itself is usually made of steel or durable plastic and rated with an IP or NEMA code to protect against dust, moisture, and impact .
