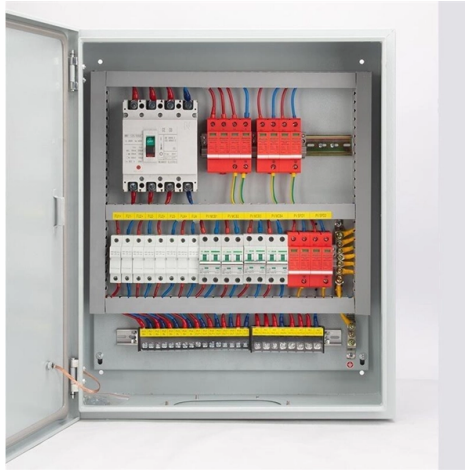


What are the different colors of the 6th core in optical fiber cable
