This method is used for flexible deployment, testing, or temporary connections. Common connectors include SC, LC, or FC types, which can be inserted or removed as needed . 4. Use of Optical Splitters: In FTTH or FTTB networks, optical splitters may be installed inside the distribution box to divide a single feeder fiber into multiple subscriber fibers. This allows one fiber to serve multiple endpoints efficiently . 5. Jumper-Free or Direct Connections: Some distribution boxes use a jumper-free design, where backbone fibers are directly spliced to distribution fibers without intermediate patch cords, reducing insertion points and potential signal loss .
