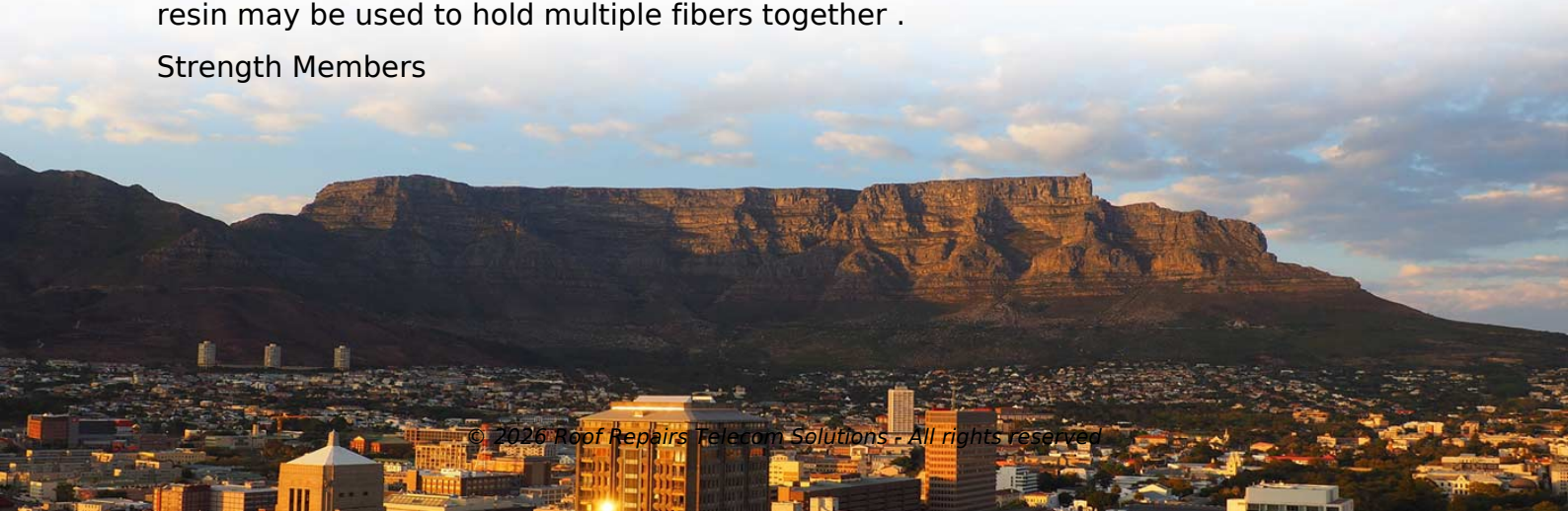

For short-distance or flexible applications, plastic optical fibers (POF) made from polymers like acrylate or polyimide may be used .

Coatings and Buffers

To protect the delicate glass or plastic fibers, a buffer coating is applied. This is usually a dual-layer UV-cured acrylate, with a soft primary layer to cushion the fiber and a hard secondary layer for mechanical protection . In ribbon cables, a UV-curable resin may be used to hold multiple fibers together .
