Overview

1976: Bell Labs built the first practical fibre optic communication system (Washington–Atlanta, 44. Since I was involved in fiber optics starting in the late 1970s, much of this is from personal experiences and memories. Dates, of course, are often approximate, as putting a firm date on the introduction. Ethernet was invented at Xerox Palo Alto Research Labs using coax cable. Digital Equipment joined Xerox to standardize Ethernet under IEEE as 803. Integrated circuit (IC) PCM codecs and SLICs introduced that allow inexpensive. In 1880, Alexander Graham Bell and his assistant Charles Sumner Tainter created a very early precursor to fiber-optic communications, the Photophone, at Bell's newly established Volta Laboratory in Washington, D. Bell considered it his most important invention.
